- Fully Open Source (GPL)

- Ability for both public and private projects.
- Access levels user/public, contributor, project team member, admin
- Support for multiple versioning systems.
- Low barrier of entry for users



- Clever ability to link with Git/SVN repos and write access files to them.

- Underlying base of Indefero
- MVC-style PHP framework
- Handles authentication, templating and data structures.

## Installation/Requirements

- •PHP 5.2.4 or above.
- •MySQL or PostgreSQL or SQLite.
- •Apache or Nginx.
- •Git or Mercurial or Subversion.
- •Reasonable shell knowledge
