What is Indefero?

- Web-based Source Code & Project Management application
- Combines functionality of SCM viewer, wiki, issue tracker and more into a single application.
- Fully Open Source (GPL)

So, why talk about indefero?

Requirements

- Provide SCM viewing, documentation and issue tracking.
- Ability for both public and private projects.
- Access levels – user/public, contributor, project team member, admin
- Support for multiple versioning systems.
- Low barrier of entry for users

So why are you telling us this?

- It's a great application
- Most people here should be using something like it - far too many companies & projects lack a decent form of project and source control!
- It's open source (GPL)
- I love PHP

Having to enter payments manually against invoices (AP or AR) can be annoying.

Some of this will be eliminated with the bank statement import feature being worked on, but this won't help when entering payments that don't yet have CSV information.

To resolve, Bex has been assigned to develop a bulk payment tool that will display a list of AR or AP invoices and allow multiple invoices to be selected for being paid.

Open Source: Amberdms Billing System Issue Tracking Configuration

Instructions:

List one status value per line in desired sort-order.

Optionally, use an equals-sign to document the meaning of each status value.

Open issue status values:

New	= Issue has not had initial review yet
Accepted	= Problem reproduced / Need acknowledged
Started	= Work on this issue has begun
Testing	= Fix/change submitted, waiting for confirmation

Closed issue status values:

Fixed	= Issue resolved
Invalid	= This was not a valid issue report
Duplicate	= This report duplicates an existing issue
WontFix	= We decided to not take action on this issue
External	= Issue was with another application/project

Predefined issue labels:

Type:Defect	= Report of a software defect
Type:Enhancement	= Request for enhancement
Type:Task	= Work item that doesn't change the code or docs
Type:Patch	= Submission to review
Type:Documentation	= Documentation Improvements
Type:Other	= Some other kind of issue
Priority:Critical	= Must resolve ASAP
Priority:High	= Strongly want to resolve ASAP

Each issue may have at most one label with each of these classes:

Type, Priority, Target

Installation instructions for developers using SVN

Installing from SVN

Interested in developing and contributing to the Amberdms Billing System? In this case, the best way is to download and run the developmental SVN version, so that you can get changes and new features as soon as they get committed.

Please note that SVN can sometimes be broken, updates might not be smooth like with regular releases and Amberdms does not recommend using SVN for production at all

1. Getting code from SVN

To checkout from SVN, follow [these instructions](#) to download to a location of your choosing.

Note that you only have to check out once, to get future versions, run `svn update` and the changes will be merged.

2. Install the database

Because you will be deploying ABS to a non-standard install path and a different database compared to production, in order to install you need to:

- Determine the latest version of `help/schema/version_*_install.sql`
- Import with:

```
$ mysql -u root -p < help/schema/version_LATESTDATE_install.sql
```

- Create a MySQL user account for the billing system only:

```
$ mysql -u root -p
```

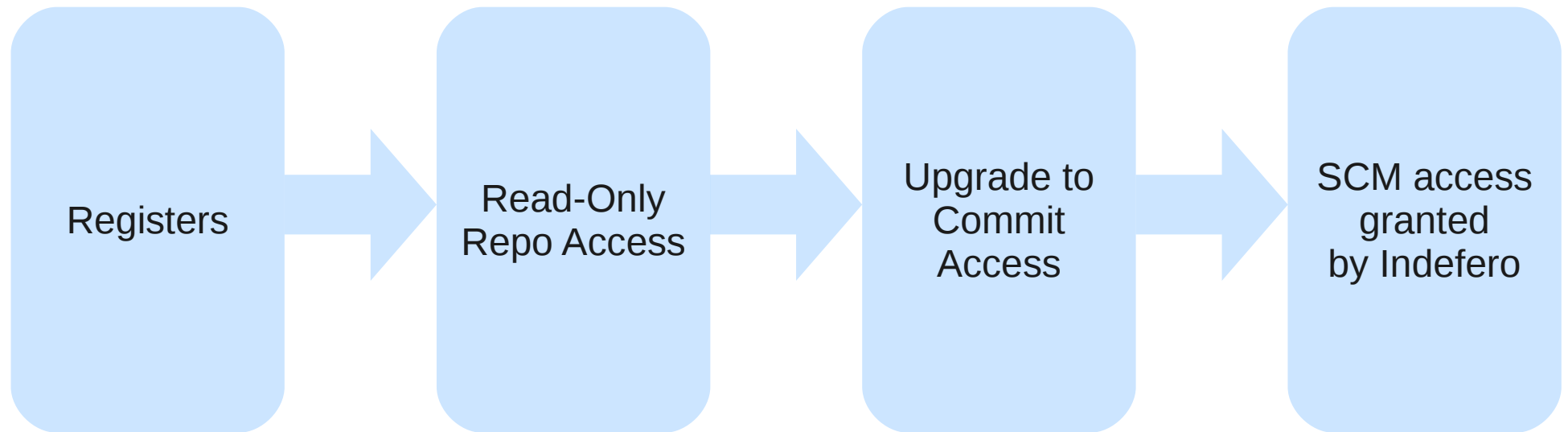

Notification emails will be sent from the **support@amberdms.com** address, if you send the email to a mailing list, you may need to register this email address. If you do not want to send emails for a given type of changes, simply leave the corresponding field empty.

If you mark a project as private, only the project members and administrators, together with the extra authorized users you provide will have access to the project. You will still be able to define further access rights for the different tabs but the "Open to all" and "Signed in users" will default to authorized users only.

- PHP 5.2.4 or above.
- MySQL or PostgreSQL or SQLite.
- Apache or Nginx.
- Git or Mercurial or Subversion.
- Reasonable shell knowledge
